

Glenmore Park High School Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program Device Specifications and Minimum System Requirements

Under the BYOD Program, personal computing devices can be brought to school to assist with student learning. This device needs to meet the Device Specifications that are recommended by the school and listed below.

The device must meet all the following requirements:

Backup	External drive or cloud-based backup solution e.g. Google Drive, OneDrive - Accessible via the DoE Student Portal.		
	Students must ensure that their files are regularly backed up.		
	Windows laptops should run Windows Defender (inbuilt with Windows) or alternative.		
Security	Note: Mac laptops come with inbuilt Antivirus but not with full scan functionality. We recommend a product named Intego x9 be installed by the user.		
Software	Antivirus and antimalware programs must be kept up to date to be effective. Many Windows laptops come with a 3 month McAfee or Norton trial. Be aware that once the trial expires the laptop is no longer secure so the software should be removed if it hasn't been purchased so that Windows Defender may become the active Antivirus program. AVG free edition is recommended for Windows and can be downloaded from the internet.
