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Dear Parents / Guardians,

Year 7 Aquatics is a compulsory component of the Stage 4 PDHPE syllabus under the content Strand 2 Movement Skill and Performance, and Strand 3 Health, safe and active lifestyle and all students are expected to attend. At Glenmore Park High, we have developed an assessable unit of work called Risky Business, which is studied in Term 4. To cover the mandatory component of this course all year 7 students must participate in the Aquatics program at Ripples Penrith on the following dates.

6th & 9th December 7 M R N
10th & 11th December 7 L E A
12th & 13th December 7 G O S

Students will be asked to attend roll call as normal each day before being transported to and from the pool by bus and they will arrive back at school by the normal time. The cost of the Aquatics program is \$25.00 (this will cover bus fare and entry into the pool for the two days). Students will be supervised and taught vital aquatic, survival skills, as well as CPR and rescue techniques by trained Glenmore Park PDHPE staff. Students will need to bring with them a swimming costume, non-fluro sunscreen, hat, lunch, water and 2 towels, and will be required to wear their full sports uniform on each day. Goggles are recommended.

The pool canteen WILL be open for lunch only. We encourage students to bring plenty of water and some fresh fruit.
