- The school day will start at 8.30am
- Students must enter and exit the school at their designated entry points:
 - Year 7 and 8: Front gate
 - Year 9 and 10: Bus Bay gate
 - Year 11: Back Car Park gate (N.B. cars are not to be brought onsite)
- All Year groups have had variation to rooming in order to organise classes into cohorts.
- Students can access their revised electronic timetable from Saturday via the Sentral Student Portal. Please monitor your student email from Saturday for the link.
- Check your Year Group Google Classroom for the organisation for the school day
- On Monday students make their way straight to school do not linger at the park/outside school/at the shops
- Students will generally remain in one room for the day and teachers will move to the students unless your electronic timetable shows otherwise.
- Make sure you pack all of your books/equipment **two masks** and sanitiser.
- If you have PE/sport on your timetable you have permission to wear PE uniform
- Due to current Department guidelines, no parents are permitted on site.
- Students should not attend school if they are unwell. If a student has been unwell, they will be required to produce a negative COVID test or isolate for 10 days prior to return
- When students arrive on Monday morning they are to go straight to the following areas while waiting for the bell for the start of the day **students should not gather in the quad:**
 - Year 7: Oval

 - Support Unit students should go to the Unit
